St. Louis Gateway to the West Regional I/N Fact Sheet

Welcome to the St. Louis Gateway to the West Regional. We are happy to see you here and hope this fact sheet helps make your tournament an enjoyable experience.

Events

I/N stands for Intermediate/Novice. Our tournament offers a number of I/N games: a free single session game for players with 0-20 masterpoints on Monday afternoon and 299er pairs games at 2 pm and 7 pm on Monday and then three times each day (9:30 AM, 2 PM, and 7 PM) Tuesday thru Saturday. Follow the I/N arrows to I/N rooms.

You may also want to play in Gold Rush pairs on Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday.

Additional means of earning gold points are the Bracketed Swiss games. Two-session Bracketed Swiss Team games are scheduled for Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday, and Sunday. These will take place in the main ballroom. The Sunday bracketed Swiss will be the largest event and gives you the best chance to earn gold.

Bracketed Swiss events are structured so that teams only play against other teams in their same bracket (brackets based on number of masterpoints of team members). There are gold point winners in each bracket. If there are 7 teams in a particular bracket, then three of those teams will earn gold.

Parking 197

Before you leave, pick up parking tickets for exiting the lot. Your director will have them. Parking is free but you must have the tickets to exit. One ticket is good for the entire tournament.

Trophies are awarded to the 1st overall winners in each I/N strata (A, B, and C).

Bring your trophy for a photograph in the main hallway after each morning and afternoon session. If you win an evening event, have your picture taken the next day. Or use your smartphone and email photograph to <u>dolanmary@sbcglobal.net</u>. Include your names (left to right) and the event date.

If you reach Life Master status during the tournament, let us know by putting note in "News For Daily Bulletin" basket on Daily Bulletin table in main hallway. And get your photo taken also.
